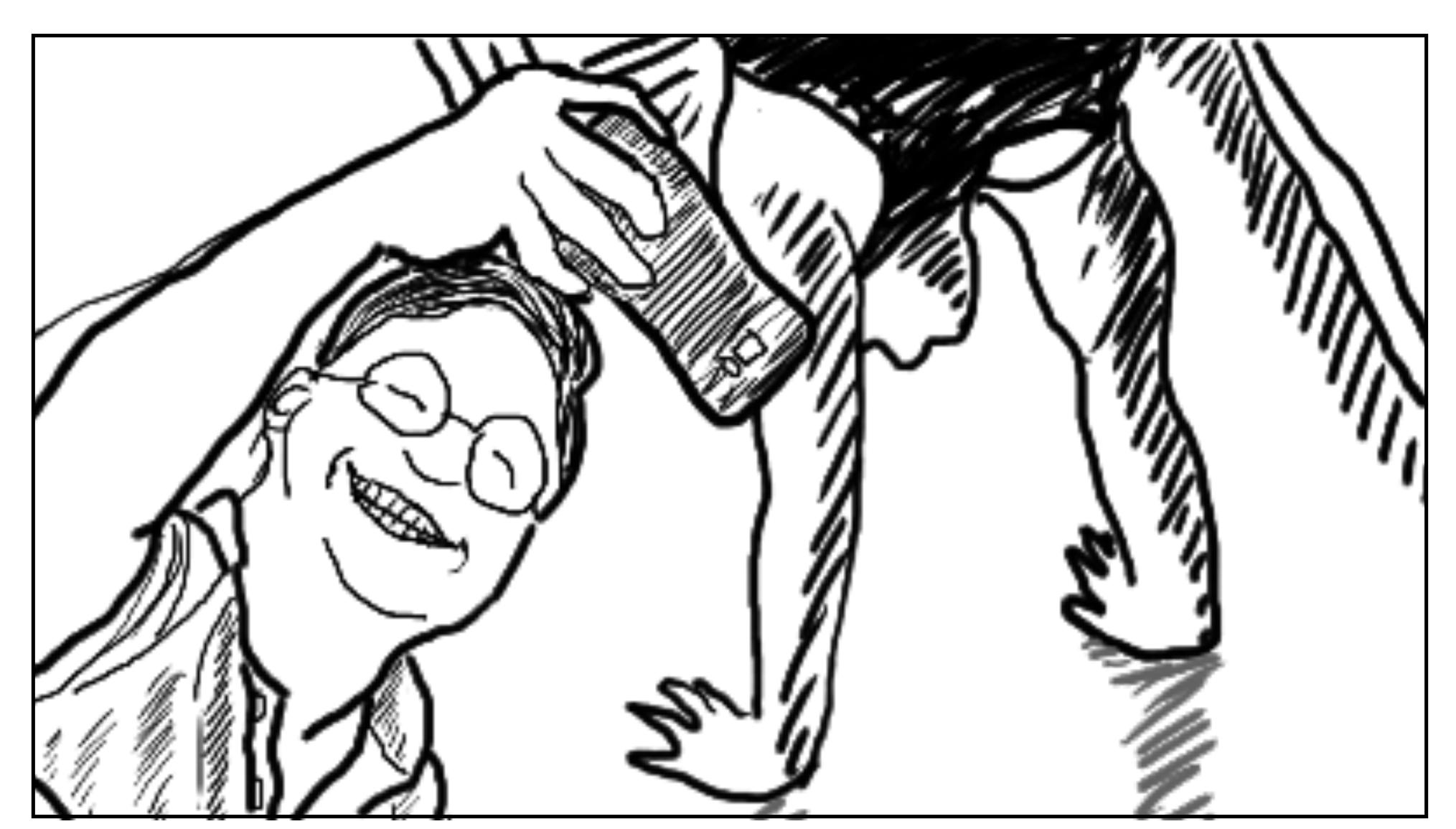

Due to its popularity, this dish can be found on most street corners and coffee shops, but a popular place to savour this iconic Penang dish is KAFE HENG HUAT in Lorong Selamat.

No trip to Penang would be complete without a sampling of its famous ASAM LAKSA (rice noodles with a spicy and sour fish broth). This is another dish that can be found all over the island, with PASAR AIR ITAM being one of the best places to try it.

A must-visit destination for history buffs is the PENANG WAR MUSEUM, which was formerly the Bukit Batu Maung Fortress. Anticipating enemy attacks during World War II, the British built the fortress to be impenetrable by sea, and so, when the Japanese invaded from inland instead, the soldiers guarding the fort were taken completely by surprise. The defenders were defeated and the fortress was consequently used as a prison. The fortress has been converted into a museum. It also maintains its claustrophobic tunnels that soldiers

For a relaxing getaway, head to **PENANG HILL.** At 2,000 feet above sea level, it's the perfect place to enjoy a beautiful panoramic view of the city. An upside to the high altitude is the cooler weather, with temperatures barely going beyond 21 degrees Celsius. At the top of the hill, immerse yourself in nature as you take a walk among the many tropical oak trees, carnivorous pitcher plants, ferns and cycads.
